DEPT of LABOR & INDUSTRIES RATE INCREASE

You should have received your Rate Notice by now announcing a 2% average increase in workers' compensation rates for 2016. This rate hike comes after three years of increases and puts a burden on employers, especially as they continue to focus on the recovery of their businesses after the Great Recession.

While the average increase for this coming year will be 2% overall, each individual risk classification will see their rates increase based on the loss experience for that classification. While many other states have seen rate decreases over the last several years, Washington's expensive workers' compensation system has continued to become even more so.

Efforts by BIAW and other business groups to reform Washington's expensive and inefficient workers' compensation monopoly have been thwarted over the years and have resulted in Washington state remaining a national leader in workers' compensation costs.
