Pho V&V is a family affair headed by husband and wife duo Bao C Tran and Kim Thu along with the help of their two children. The family united on US soil in 2000 and opened the doors to their business in 2006. Since that day they've been tapping into their life-long love of culinary arts to offer Vietnamese cuisine to the South Tacoma community in a cozy, clean restaurant. Their business recipe for success is full of homemade excellence and void of MSG, a proud commitment stated on the reader board and by Bao himself as he cashes out customers at the register. The family's tenured success on South Tacoma Way is a testament to the diversity of trade and skill they share, from the couple's house made sauces and soups, met with Bao's hand in electrical engineer for in house repairs and their children's website assistance.

The dishes served at Pho V&V come at a friendly price for the hardworking people of South Tacoma. Menu items range from a few dollars for appetizers to \$10.50 for the Shrimp Salad Vermicelli Bowl. For just \$13.96, customers can pair a steaming bowl of Beef Brisket (steak, chicken, tofu or veggie) Pho and the Bahn Mi Special, packed with a combination of meat, tofu and veggies. Every dish is served with a plate of fresh crunchy sprouts and peppers, aromatic basil and a juicy lime slice. Hot sauces are also on hand for those who prefer to kick up the heat.

The menu is made up of traditional favorites with an ambiance that exceeds expectations, from the deer head mounted at the entrance and the grandfather clock guarding the kitchen. You're guaranteed to be greeted by soothing jazz melodies from the moment you step in the door. Whether it's the tunes, the endearing history of this family, or their ongoing pursuit to ensure a healthy meal in a clean and comfortable atmosphere, it's certainly a South Tacoma destination well worth a visit on an empty stomach.

## BRING YOUR OWN BAG (BYOB) Ordinance

**REMINDER:** The BYOB ordinance goes into effect on **July 12, 2017**.

The BYOB law is a ban on thin plastic bags (less than 2.25 mils). Retailers will collect a minimum pass-through charge of five cents for each recycled paper or reusable carryout bag requested by customers. The law is meant to reduce waste and littering and encourages shoppers to bring their own bag rather than buying a new bag each time they shop. Annually, retailers will be asked to report to the city on the number of recycled paper carryout bags distributed to help determine the effectiveness of the law. 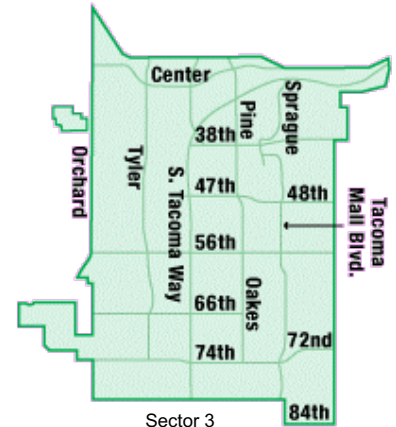
