SECTOR 3 SPOTLIGHT of the MONTH

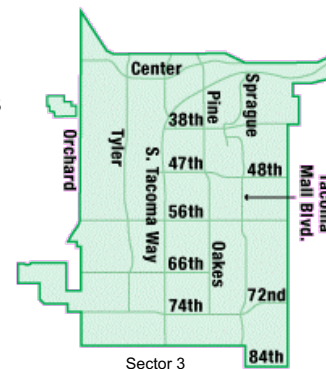


Officer Jason Mills
