



### Tacoma TMC 18.10 “Paid Sick Leave”

City staff are launching the public process to update the paid sick leave rules that will guide implementation of the revised law. We anticipate that the draft rules will be published on the City’s website by end of day on Friday, November 3rd

([www.cityoftacoma.org/employmentstandards](http://www.cityoftacoma.org/employmentstandards)).

Amendments to the paid sick leave rules will primarily focus on continued alignment with State law and minimizing administrative burden for employers.

Feedback and questions on the draft rules will be accepted through 4pm on Friday, December 1, 2017.
