Eddie & Mary Turner are the owners of **Around The Corner Café 2** which opened at 5640 South Tacoma Way November 20th . This Tacoma location is an addition to their original café which is located in Orting.

Eddie’s kitchen resume reads like the Who’s Who of South Sound Diners, having worked at The Poodle Dog, The Harvester, Knapps (all in Tacoma) and Burs in Lakewood. **Around The Corner Café 2** is a little hole-in-the-wall café with a big menu. The décor has a 50’s feel with its dine-in counter, checkerboard floor and comfortable booths.

Currently serving breakfast and lunch, you can order breakfast at any time. They are well known for their 5-Pound Hobo Hash. Yes, that’s five pounds of meat, eggs and potatoes with a blanket of cheddar cheese on top. There is a smaller version, but why when you can get a “To Go Box”?

Their lunch menu includes 20 sandwiches, 7 burgers, paninis, fish and chips and a variety of salads. Their burgers are “hand pressed” Angus beef & start at \$6.99.

**HANGING FLOWER BASKETS
to ONCE AGAIN LINE STW**

The general STBDA membership approved the 2018 Budget of expenses as their February 8th meeting and also approved a line item to support the hanging flower baskets once again. Proceeds from last summer’s car show will help to fund this project.



The baskets, hangers, plants and soil have been delivered to the Mount Tahoma High School green house and the plant biology classes will plant and care for the baskets until they are ready to be transported to the business district in mid-late May. Instructor Eric Knight and his assistant John Valentine will be heading up this project.

We are also partnering, once again, with Communities in Schools who will provide students to water the baskets once they are hung. For some students, this could be their “first job”. The STBDA purchased a 30-gallon water cart a number of years ago from a farm supply company. You might remember seeing the students pulling this cart along STW last summer. Various local businesses have allowed the students to fill up the water cart from their storefront faucets. We will once again be contacting those businesses to partner with us once again.

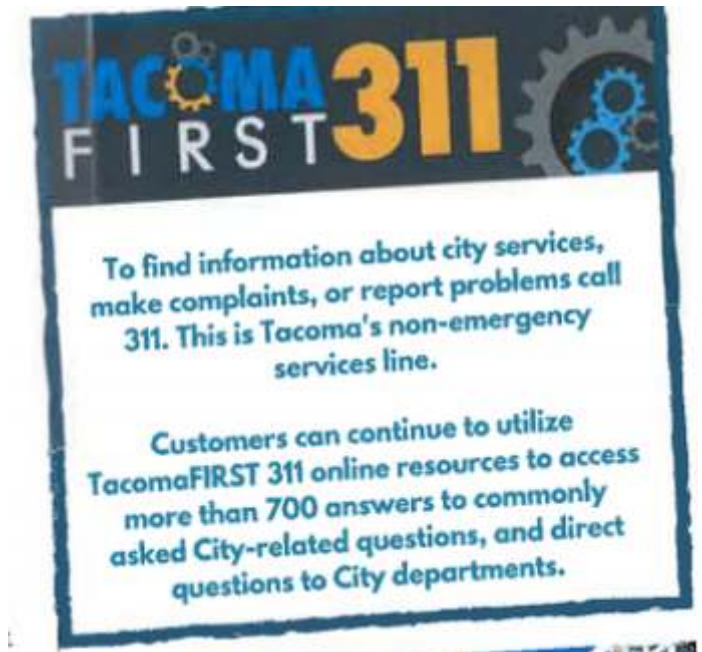

If you've every filled out a product warranty card, purchased a new home or vehicle or simply carried a credit card, you can be sure that your name and address are being circulated among an array of credit card companies hungry for your business. To eliminate credit card promotional mailings, visit <http://www.optoutprescreen.com> you will have the opportunity to choose either a five-year removal or a permanent removal. For your personal credit cards, ask the company to place you on their "in house" list that is not sold or traded to other companies.
